Warning for Cyclonic Storm "BUREVI"

For the land and the sea areas around the island

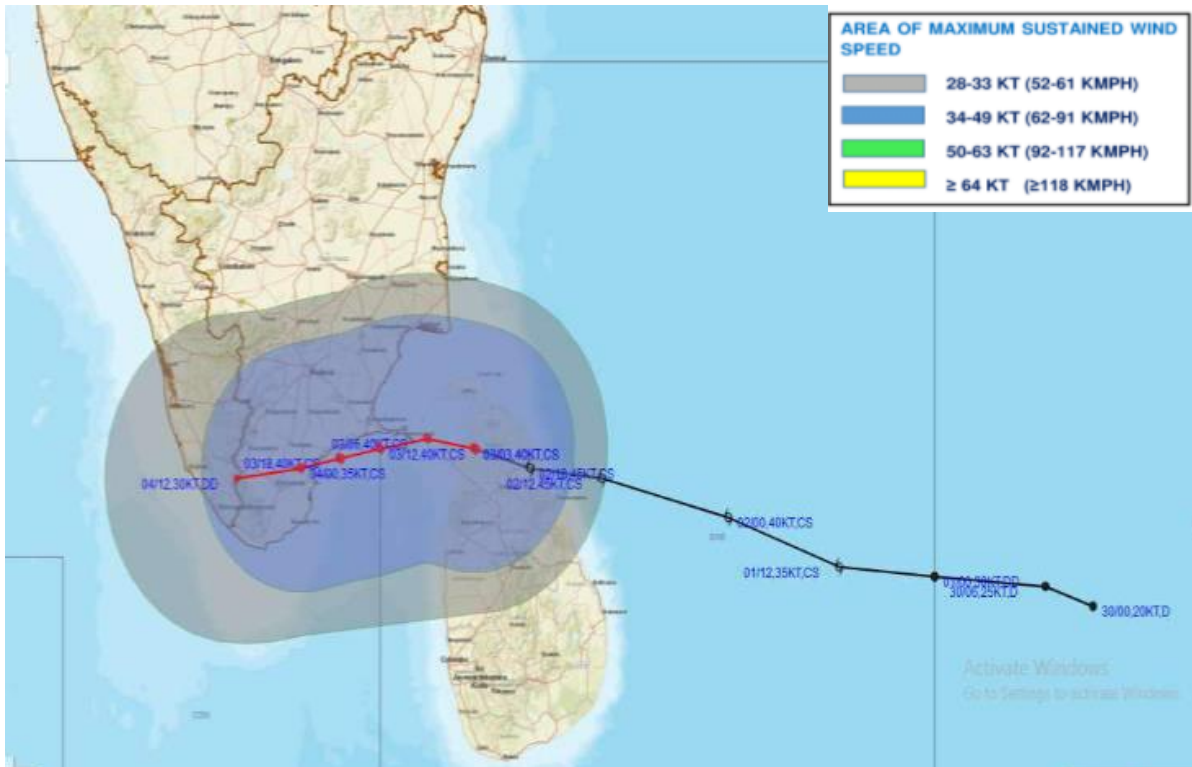
PLEASE BE AWARE!

The cyclonic storm 'BUREVI' is now located closer to coastal area in between Mannar and Punarin and it is gradually moving away from the island.

This Cyclonic storm with a wind speed of 70-80 kmph gusting up to 90 kmph is very likely to move west-northwestwards thereafter, emerge into Gulf of Mannar by to morning (December 03).

Due to this system Storm surge of about 1-meter height above the astronomical tide is likely to inundate low lying coastal areas extending from Pooneryn to Puttalam.

Showers or thundershowers will occur at times in the Northern, North-western and North-central provinces. Heavy rainfall about (100-150) mm can be expected at some places.

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For Sea Area
